The New Reuse & Recycling Guides Are Here

The 2005 Reuse & Recycling Guide is in almost every address in San Bernardino County, but few realize their good fortune. The guide is located inside the SBC and Verizon phone books in the “Recycling” section of the yellow pages. Zero Waste Communities of San Bernardino County produced the guide to help reduce the amount of waste generated, promote the reuse of materials whenever practical, and encourage the recycling of materials instead of having them thrown away. These actions will not only save landfill space, but also money and natural resources.

The guide provides contact information for recycling coordinators, a section on what to place in your curbside recycling container, listings of recycling centers and businesses, and information on how to dispose of household hazardous waste, bulky items, and green waste. It also contains a section with listings of businesses that may buy, sell, repair, or recycle products and materials that you may be interested in. All of the businesses help divert materials away from the landfill, one way or another.
